Be Not Weary

Two of the advantages of maturing in ministry is Observance and Perspective. Being in full time ministry for sixty five years allows one to look over the immediate, and fixate on those things of eternal value.

In these years of service, I have seen many "movements; destinies; outpourings; and revivals come and go. I have watched excitements, outpourings, miracles and non-affiliated fellowships surge and subside. I have seen small churches come into being; grow to huge evangelistic centers, only to be bulldozed and gone.

But most disturbing has been watching individuals come; get excited; join; recruit others; follow the leadership (sometimes because it is a requirement to be a part of the movement) only to become disillusioned because of failed leadership; perceived hypocrisy in the movement; moral failure; or family disintegration. These former followers are now going nowhere to fellowship and have become cynical.

As I have watched this society destroying pattern, I have tried to analyze the basic problem in all of these scenarios. My analysis was not done to criticize or belittle, but to try to avoid the same problem in my own calling. I completely realize; But by the grace of God; there go ANY of us.

In Luke 8; Jesus spoke of such happenings, and gave a warning to us. When He spoke of the "sower who went forth to sow," He spoke of the "stony ground" problem. In verse 6; He said; "And some fell upon a rock; and as soon as it was sprung up, it withered away, because IT LACKED MOISTURE." Then again; in vs. 13; He said; "They on the rock are they, which, when they hear, receive the word with joy; and these have NO ROOT, which for a while believe, and in time of temptation fall away."

Many of the millions I have seen come and go from excitement to emptiness down through the years are those who "lack moisture."

The first moisture they have lacked is having a personal relationship with the "Water of Life." It is not enough to get excited; join a fellowship; tithe; etc. Unless you and I have a

PERSONAL, INTIMATE, moment by moment realtionship with the only one who promised us eternal life, and to never leave us or forsake us; we will not stand when the disappointments and disasters of life come. Jesus; "The Water of Life" said; "He that HATH THE SON, has LIFE." Many of those formerly excited about the Gospel, failed to meet the Water of Life Himself; and became "Weary in well doing."

The second problem these "fallen away groups" experienced was failing to drink every day of the LIVING WATER= Jesus Christ. Jesus said: John **6:54** "Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except ye EAT the flesh of the Son of man, and DRINK his blood, ye have NO LIFE in you." PLEASE NOTE: I DID NOT SAY THIS! Jesus said it. He also said "I don't SAY anything, or DO anything; EXCEPT the Father tells

So, in reality; these are the requirements of the Creator God. The Eternal Father, and of Jesus Christ, our Redeemer! This portion could not be more AUTHORITATIVE! You and I can do religious things every day, only to hear Him say: "Depart from me, for I NEVER knew you." Religious, but lost!

Jesus Christ is not looking for commitment: but communion; worship, and a funeral.

This brings us to the second aspect of "Lack of moisture."

WATER BAPTISM:

It is sad in the present day denominational emphasis period that baptism has become a divisive element instead of a unifying force.

Churches today spend all of their time arguing about their special mode of baptism: ie, immersion; sprinkling; face down; in Jesus name only; " in the name of the Father, Son, and the Holy Ghost." To many, it is the final step before someone can join THE Church.

In reality, baptism is a DIVINE SYMBOL. According to Paul the Apostle, who received his total revelation directly from Jesus Christ. In Romans 6, Pauls tells us baptism is a symbol of DEATH. It is the recognition that Jesus Christ died IN OUR PLACE on the cross. He took our punishment for OUR sin. We should have been on that cross because of our own sins. But Jesus became God's Lamb, to pay for the sins of the world. When we submit to baptism; we are declaring: Jesus took my place on the cross to provide the forgiveness of our sin. When I come to Christ for forgiveness; I agree to die to my own self; my own desires; my own goals; and pray: "Thy Kingdom come, Thy will be done." Gal. 2:20 says; "I AM crucified with Christ (Present tense) nevertheless, I live! Yet, not I, but Christ LIVES IN ME, and the life I now live in the flesh, I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me."

This is exactly why Jesus said: Mark 8:34; "Whosoever will come after me, let him DENY himself, and take up HIS CROSS, and follow me." In Luke 14:27; Jesus said: "And WHOSOEVER doth not BEAR HIS CROSS, and come after me, CANNOT BE MY DISCIPLE." I keep asking people: "Which part of CANNOT do you not understand?"

Baptism is a SYMBOLIC DECLARATION that I am dead to the world; to my desires; to the world's standards; and to false religious doctrines. I am committed to the Lordship of Jesus Christ; filled with His Spirit; called to holiness and fruitfulness; only as the Lord opens the doors of opportunity. I must be willing to say; "Lord I am willing to go ANYWHERE; or NOWHERE. I am willing to be ANYTHING, OR NOTHING." "Thy Kingdom come, Thy will be done." I do not care what OTHERS think of me. You said: Matt. 5:11, 12'"BLESSED are ye, when men shall REVILE you, and PERSECUTE you, and shall say all manner of evil against you FALSELY for my sake. REJOICE and be EXCEEDING GLAD: FOR great is your REWARD IN heaven: for so PERSECUTED they the prophets which were before you."

The reason we have so many discouraged religious people today is they are dying of thirst by sucking on the water that doesn't satisfy: human reason; religious reasonings; and not going back to the cross to admit and repent of crawling off God's altar of sacrifice; putting your own desires and feelings ahead of doing the perfect will of God. We are not to leave our first love; but to constantly reaffirm our commitment to Christs'

Many of you reading this newsletter, at one time strongly believed the covenant marriage message. When you began to express it, you were assailed by just about everyone. Your friends stood afar off and family members isolated you and said all manner of terrible things about you. Some of you had children who divorced and remarried and you "didn't want to lose your children." Consequently, you now read this newsletter, wondering how long it will be before I quit.

Let me tell you right now: I couldn't care less what people think about the message the Holy Spirit gave me to preach. It is the truth and I REFUSE to allow others to dissuade me from the clear call of God on my life. I am determined to chew on the devil until I lose all of my teeth, and then gum him till Jesus calls me home. The message is just as true to God's holy word now, as it was the day He called me to preach it. We have seen scores of people come and go. From totally committed to total indifference. They became "Weary in well doing." Paul warned believers of his day: Gal. 6:9; "and let us NOT be WEARY in well doing: for in DUE SEASON we SHALL REAP; IF WE FAINT NOT." II Thess. 3:13; ".But ye brethren, BE NOT WEARY IN WELL DOING." Again, in **II Thess. 15:58;** Paul admonished believers:


Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye STEADFAST, UNMOVEABLE, always abounding in the WORK OF THE LORD, forasmuch as you KNOW that your LABOR is NOT in vain IN THE LORD."

You might ask: Brother Webb, don't you ever get WEARY? YES, but whenever I do, I go back to the CROSS and say: NOT MY WILL, BUT THINE BE DONE." "I am CRUCIFIED with Christ. I am His bond slave; I own NOTHING. I am God's steward, and it is REQUIRED that a STEWARD be found FAITHFUL." I disown and deny myself any rights. I AM DEAD! Lord, what would You have me to do?

If you are WEARY, go back to the cross; have a first class funeral; give your friends, children, parents, back to Jesus Christ, and put Him back on the throne of your heart: saying: Lord, what would YOU have me to do? If you have a successful burial, He will begin to use you again. Put Jesus Christ and His will first in your life, and refuse to allow EVERYTHING AND EVERYONE ELSE to affect your commitment to Him; His word; and His will for your life. *Jesus said*, "If any man drink of the water I shall give him, he WILL NEVER THIRST AGAIN. AMEN!

You, like myself, probably knowingly smiled as you read this progression of attitude found in so many of us. What can we learn from this pattern?

First; We must see the vital influence every father should have in the lives of their children. Today, nearly half of the children born end up in single parent homes, with partial understanding of stability and safety. Whenever anyone marries; has children and separate; they are violating a vital and sacred symbol of Christ and His Church. It is God's desire that both parents join together to "TRAIN UP their children in the fear and admonition of the Lord." The children are to be obedient to their parents and see a clear picture of God's perfect plan for every couple; "train them up" by principle and by example. By principle means; line upon line and precept upon precept; each parent supporting the other with respect and common desire: to raise up a "Godly generation."

By example means, let your walk agree with your talk. When this fails to happen, a door is opened in the heart of a child to disrespect the disrespectful conduct by their parents. Their response is; "Why should we do what you say when you don't do it yourselves? James 3:17 tells us: "The wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, full of mercy, and easy to be entreated, and good fruits, wihout partiality, and WITHOUT HYPOCRISY."

Application: Say what you mean and mean what you say. Be genuine. If you miss it; admit it, ask for forgiveness and change your conduct. Anything less than this is not from above, and promotes resentment, unforgiveness and distrust. What does our conduct give to our children to process, whenever they begin to contemplate relationships? Someone once said: "Whatever we do in moderation; our children will do to excess." Think about that when you display the meaning of a COVENANT marriage in your home.

What can children learn from the progressive illustration above? First, they should learn that God EXPECTS them to honor their parents; whether they deserve it or not. The parents may not deserve respect because of their terrible conduct, but God still COMMANDS: "Children, honor you father and mother." "Children, obey your parents, for this is right."

Our God is a God of order. He has established "offices." Children are to honor and obey their parents, regardless of their conduct; unless they ask us to do something contrary to the Word of God.

If your parents are doing a lousy job of parenting; that does not give us an excuse to dishonor or belittle them. The word of God says: "Vengeance is mine, I will repay, saith the Lord." A child's responsibility is to honor and obey their parents regardless of their conduct (and in my sixty years of ministry I have seen some terrible parental conduct.) Remember: God judges each of us separately. What your parents do, they will answer to God. How you respond to their terrible conduct, God will judge you. It is our responsibility to realize no parent is perfect. Being a parent does not come with a manufacturer's manual. It is a learn as you go program. God's word says: "When your father and mother hath forsaken you, then will the Lord take you up."

I cannot tell you how many times, as a father, I had to go to my children and ask them, "Please forgive me. "I really missed it." "Dad really blew it kids, and I am very sorry. Please forgive me." This was not easy, but it taught them that everyone makes mistakes and must admit it and quit it. Every time I corrected my children for their immediately afterwards, I would take them in my arms and let them know they were forgiven, and the Lord loved them very much. They knew if they disobeyed in the same way again, the punishment would be greater the next time, but the past indiscretion was over.

Some parents would rather send their child to their room to "think about what they had done." To do this does two things: 1. It causes them to identify their room with punishment; and 2. It allows them to store up resentment and bitterness for their correction. Whenever our discipline session was over I would have them pray and thank the Lord for His total forgiveness; "NEVER to be remembered again," and their acknowledgement of their wrongdoing according to the Word of God.

A good example of this in scripture is of David and Saul. Saul's conduct was vicious and ungodly, but David respected the "office" when he could not respect the person. David was encouraged to take advantage of Saul and kill him when Saul was chasing him through the wilderness. David's response was: "Touch not the Lord's anointed, and do his servant no harm." Did Saul's conduct deserve this respect? No! But David understood God's divine order of "offices." He knew God appointed Saul to be king, and if He wanted it different, God didn't need any help.

May I encourage children today to respect the office of mother and father. If you miss this vital truth, you are inviting Divine wrath. "Whatsoever you

sow, you shall also reap." Be careful what you sow today, because it WILL come back later on, multiplied many times over.

Wherever you and I find ourselves displaying a wrong attitude, please remember, we do not have the luxury of responding however we want to because "they deserve it!" Jesus said: "Humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God and He will exalt you." I would rather obey God's plan and be blessed and prosper, than to do it my way. I would rather humble my self under the mighty hand of God and let Him exalt me in His time.

Remember: God established the marriage and the family. He established divine offices. Honor them and He will honor you; rebel against them at your own peril. "For whatsoever you sow, that shall you also reap." This truth can bring healing to many homes, if we are willing to "humble ourselves and know His way is perfect."

I could recall for you many examples where I taught this truth to children who were in rebellion, and ask them to try God's way and see what happens. Without exception, the Lord honored their faith and obedience to honor their parents in spite of their conduct; and today, everyone of them have been promoted to responsible, productive lives, with happy famililes of their own. Remember: "There is a way that seems right to a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death."

Another example of allowing the Lord to correct wrong conduct is in **I Sam. 1-4**. Here we learn of Eli, the high priest of Israel. God chose Eli and his family to serve in this capacity forever. We are told Eli, as a father, "preferred his sons over the Lord." His sons were "sons of Belial." They raped the women who brought offerings to the tabernacle and stole consecrated offerings from those fulfilling God's commands concerning proper offerings.

The scripture says Eli knew of this and did nothing to stop it. When Eli failed to fulfil his obligation to his high office, even when the people complained; the Lord changed His mind and declared Eli's office of responsibility was over and his sons would be killed.

Soon after, Hophni and Phinehas were slain in battle because of their wickedness and violations of God's holy standard. "When their father heard of it, he fell over backwards and broke his neck and died."

Please note: The people didn't have to handle it. The same holy God who said: "vengeance is mine, I will repay saith the Lord." handled it. His law is absolute: "Whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap." We need to be careful what we choose to plant. **AMEN!**

Authors response: Do we really wonder why we are not having a genuine revival in our churches today? We must be reminded of Paul's admonition for all true believers: **Phil. 4:8** "Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, THINK ON THESE THINGS."

In **Matthew 5:28**, Jesus said: "whosoever looketh on a woman to lust after her hath committed ADULTERY WITH HER already in his heart."

In I Cor. 6:9, 10; Paul said: "Know ye not that the unrighteous SHALL NOT inherit the kingdom of God. BE NOT DECEIVED: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor ADULTERERS, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind, Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioner, shall inherit the kingdom of God."

Please Note: all of these categories are declared to be SIN: But here, Paul is speaking of each of them as LIFESTYLES. He is saying; if you call yourself a Christian and live any of these lifestyles, reexamine your hearts: be sure you are truly in the faith. Scriptures clearly tell us: II Cor. 5:17; "Therefore if any man be in Christ, he IS a new creature; old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new."

May the Lord renew our minds daily.

Many pastors today avoid these subject whenever possible; knowing if they teach what the Word of God truly says about these lifestyles, the financial and social repercussions would affect their budgets in a negative way. For the sake of peace and harmony, many pastors talk a good talk, but refuse to unashamedly "PREACH THE WORD." Whose servant are they?

We must remember; "The fear of man is a SNARE." "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of WISDOM."

Am I correct in my understanding that if and when she dies, I could then again marry if the Lord sent someone my way? I have repented for the second two marriages.

Thank you for your inquiry concerning the whole truth about a covenant marriage. A covenant marriage, according to scripture, is where a man and a woman, for the first time each, pledge themselves to one another as husband and wife. Scripture tells us when this happens, each individual is entering into a covenant, instituted by God Himself; the terms of which is; "Till Death Do Us Part." "What GOD has joined together, NO MAN may separate."

In three places in the Old Testament, it says "It is better, NEVER to make a vow to God, than to make it and to say it was a mistake, and break it. If you do, you are a FOOL, and God will destroy the work of your hands." In Luke 16:18; Jesus said, "WHOSOEVER divorces his wife and marries another, COMMITS ADULTERY against her." NOTE: The Greek tense indicates this "adultery" to be a STATE OF BEING, and not just an act. In other words, it constitutes adultery the whole time a person remains in it.

When you connect this truth with **I Cor. 6:9-11**, you will see the eternal consequences involved if one remains in an adulterous lifestyle. "BE NOT DECEIVED, neither fornicators, nor idolaters. NOR ADULTERERSshall inherit the Kingdom of God." The categories listed is not describing just an immoral act, but a SINFUL LIFESTYLE.

If one is interested as to what constitutes a New Testament, born again experience, let them read **Luke 14:25-35**. In this passage, Jesus says; if you are truly born again; the evidence will be as follows: vs. 26: There will be no RIVALS in your life. Jesus will be your magnificent obsession. Everyone else will have to get in line for our attention. Vs. 27; NO REFUSALS: The cross Jesus bore was in the garden, when He prayed: "Not my will, but thine be done." We LOSE our lives, so we can gain eternal life. If we hold on to this life, we will lose everything. Many today want Jesus to be Lord of their lives as long as they can be Prime Minister. Jesus does not waver on this subject: "Thou shalt love the Lord thy God, with ALL thine heart, and with

ALL thy mind, with ALL thy strength." All else is just RELIGION!

In verses 28-32, Jesus warns us to COUNT THE COST if we are going to "come to Him."

Then, in vs. 33; Jesus says: "And likewise, whosoever he be of you that FORSAKETH NOT ALL THAT HE HATH, he CANNOT be My disciple." My first question here is; Which part of CANNOT do we not understand? Jesus didn't say, "you might not, or there is a chance you won't be my disciple." Instead, He said "YOU CANNOT BE MY DISCIPLE."

Whenever one scripturally COMES to Jesus; he makes a quality decision to make Jesus, Lord of his life; recognizing Christ died in his/her place on the cross. When we accept Him; we are to be baptized, to indicate we IDENTIFY with Him on the cross. We realize He died for us, and now He wants us to DIE TO OURSELVES and become His "bond slave and steward." We no longer OWN anything. He has purchased us completely. It now becomes our lifetime calling to find out why he called us and to totally submit ourselves to His direction in every aspect of our lives. If you make this type of QUALITY DECISION for Jesus Christ, the rest will be easy. Yes, IF you and your first partner were first time; never married before, who vowed yourselves to each other: That became a VOW, that established a LIFETIME COVENANT. You are and will be married to her till one of you die. Your task now should be to RESTORE that relationship, and forgive one another for VIOLATING (not breaking) your marriage covenant. Then you are required, as believers, to FORGIVE one another EVEN AS Christ has forgiven you.

If you say; "They don't deserve it!" Jesus will say: "Neither did you deserve My forgiveness." If you don't forgive seventy seven times a day; neither will your Heavenly Father forgive YOUR trespasses."

IF or when one of you passes away, the covenant ends and, although it is better to remain single; you are free to marry another who has never been married before, or is a widow or widower.
