As we stated in the introduction, today, we are faced with a similar dilemma. We are confronted with a secular (humanistic) worldview which Joel Belz, Founder of the well-known World Christian news magazine; calls "nominalism," and you might well conclude it as being "practical secularism." If we are to hold to a biblical worldview concerning divorce and remarriage, the question must still be answered; Whom shall we then believe?

Should we believe Jesus, Paul, and all of the earliest Church Fathers, or should we believe Erasmus and the Reformers? It was Paul who commanded Timothy, "Follow me even as I also follow Christ," I Corinthians 12:1.

This critical question must be answered because of the devastating consequences the present-day teaching has brought upon the Christian community.

Paul received his message directly from Jesus Christ and passed it on to Timothy so he could pass it on to "faithful men." *Il Timothy 2:2*

The position of the earliest Church Fathers and the position of Erasmus and the reformers are in total opposition to each other, so both cannot be right.

Whom shall we then believe? That question must be answered by each of us individually.

Every verse of Scripture relating to marriage and divorce when properly exegeted, comes into total harmony historically, hermeneutically, exegetically, and doctrinally. It is imperative for us to see how far the Church has strayed in its present-day teachings from God's eternal purpose for marriage. Study it with your Bible open. Get its truth down into your heart and lovingly warn others before it's too late.


UPDATE FROM LATVIA
