Words of Wisdom from Solomon's

Mother

Proverbs 31:1-9

"1 The sayings of King Lemuel contain this message,^[a] which his mother taught him.

2 O my son, O son of my womb,

O son of my vows,

*3 do not waste your strength on women,
on those who ruin kings.*

4 It is not for kings, O Lemuel, to guzzle wine.

Rulers should not crave alcohol.

*5 For if they drink, they may forget the law
and not give justice to the oppressed.*

*6 Alcohol is for the dying,
and wine for those in bitter distress.*

*7 Let them drink to forget their poverty
and remember their troubles no more.*

*8 Speak up for those who cannot speak for
themselves;*

ensure justice for those being crushed.

*9 Yes, speak up for the poor and helpless,
and see that they get justice."*

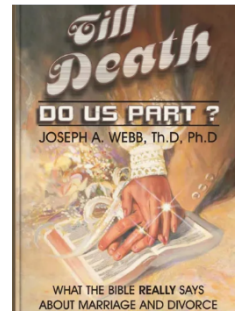
